

After his postdoctoral research fellowship at Harvard Medical School, he obtained his training in plastic and hand surgery at the University Hospital Freiburg, Germany, Presently, he is head of the department of Plastic and Aesthetic Surgery at the SANA-Clinic in Düsseldorf, specializing in aesthetic and reconstructive breast surgery. His aesthetic clinic is located at Königsalle 88 in Düsseldorf. He has been awarded several research grants and received various honors.



ERIC AUCLAIR Plastic Surgeon Paris, France

Dr. Eric Auclair exercises in Paris for more than twenty

years. Member of the French Society of Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery (SOFCPRE) and the International Society of Aesthetic and Plastic Surgery (ISAPS), he was President of the French Society of Aesthetic Plastic Surgery (SOFCEP) in 2012.

Internationally renowned plastic surgeon, Dr. Eric Auclair is thought leader in the field of breast augmentation. He is one of the leaders of the French touch. This French specificity reflects the practice of cosmetic surgery tailored interventions characterized by natural





testing targeted agents in the field of breast cancer and large national trials testing implementation of high throughput technologies in the health care system.

He has published more than 100 peer reviewed papers, including papers in the New England Journal of Medicine, Lancet, Nature Medicine, Journal of Clinical Oncology and Lancet Oncology, either as main or co-author.

Professor André is chairman of the biomarker group at UNICANCER (French cooperative group). He was a member of several scientific committees for international meetings, including ECCO, ESMO, and IMPAKT.



FABRICE ANDRE Medical Oncologist Villejuif, France

Fabrice André, MD, PhD, received his M.D. in Grenoble in

2002, and a PhD in Biotechnology from Paris University in 2005.

He spent one year as visiting assistant professor at the University of Texas, MD Anderson Cancer Center and was a past recipient of Young Investigator and Career Development awards from the American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO). He is currently Professor in the Department of Medical Oncology, Institut Gustave Roussy, Villejuif, France.

Professor André is conducting research in the field of biomarkers and personalised therapies. His research work focuses on biomarker discovery, development of targeted agents and implementation of personalised medicine in France. His team includes 50 people working on basic sciences, bioinformatics, biotechnologies and clinical research. Professor André is also leading phase I-III trials

JEFFREY A. ASCHERMAN Plastic Surgeon New York, USA

Dr. Ascherman is Chief of the Division of Plastic Sur-

gery and a Professor of Surgery at Columbia University Medical Center. He attended Harvard University where he obtained a B.A. degree with honors in Engineering Sciences. Following this, he received his M. D. from Columbia University's College of Physicians and Surgeons, and he then completed his general and plastic surgery training at the Columbia University Medical Center. In addition, he completed a craniofacial fellowship at Hopital Necker Enfants Malades in Paris.

Dr. Ascherman is an experienced plastic and reconstructive surgeon who has published over 75 scientific articles and chapters, and has presented his work at a number of national and international meetings. He is a member of numerous plastic surgery societies, including the American Society of Plastic Surgeons, the American Society for Aesthetic Plastic Surgery, the American Association of Plastic Surgeons, and the Northeastern Society of Plastic Surgeons where he is President-Elect. Dr. Ascherman currently serves as Principal Investigator for the U.S. multi-center AirXpander trial examining a new type of remote control breast tissue

expander that is self-controlled and filled with CO2 rather than saline. He has been an active participant in humanitarian surgical missions, and has traveled numerous times to China as well as to South America to perform volunteer surgeries.



MICHAEL ATLAN **Plastic Surgeon** Paris, France

Michael ATLAN, MD, PhD is an associate Professor, at Pierre

et Marie Curie Faculty of Medicine, with a permanent position in Tenon Hospital (Assistance Publique-Hôpitaux de Paris) in an integrated Breast Cancer Center. Former head of department of Pontoise Hospital, he now is the head of Unit of Plastic and Reconstructive surgery, and pursues an academic career within his institution. With three other surgeons and two residents, his team practices aesthetic surgery and has the responsibility of dermatologic, thoracic, abdominal wall and pelvic post-oncological surgery defects. He did his residency in France between Lille and Paris (Pr Lantiéri Team) and he got a position for a Microsurgical and Hand Surgery Fellowship in Montreal and a Breast Reconstruction Fellowship in the University Of British Columbia, in Vancouver. Michael Atlans's areas of expertise are microsurgical breast reconstructions (Free flaps and Lymphedema) and the evaluation of plastic surgery innovations, especially for breast surgery (Acellular regeneration Matrix and other devices).



Dr Corinne BALLEYGUIER, MD, PhD, radiologist at Gus-

tave Roussy Cancer Campus, Villejuif, France. Specialized in Women Imaging, Breast and gynaecologic Imaging. She is a member of the French radiological society (SFR), the French breast Imaging society (elected as active

member since 2010) (SIFEM), the European Society of Radiology (ESR), the European Society of Breast Imaging (EUSOBI)- Active member elected since 2012, the European Society of Uro-genital Radiology (ESUR), the Radiological Society of North American Radiology, the editorial board European Journal of Radiology-Woman imaging and the ESUR gynaecological subcommittee since 2008. She is a section editor on Woman Imaging for European Journal of Radiology since 2010. Dr Balleyguier is involved in breast Imaging committee for ECR 2012-2013-2014-2015. She was the Chairwoman of Uro-Gynecological Imaging of ECR 2010 and will be the Chairwoman of breast imaging committee for ECR 2016.

CORINNE BECKER **Plastic Surgeon Paris. France**

Dr. Corinne Becker is a pioneer surgeon that developed the

microsurgical autologous lymph node transfer (ALNT), also known as vascularized lymph node transfer (VLNT). Her first steps in general and plastic surgery and research began in Belgium (with Pr Bremmer, Carpentier, Graff). But her real training was performed in France in plastic surgery, hand surgery and microsurgery. She had the big honour to work with Pr Michon, Tubiana, Merle, Gilbert, Hidden, Riquet), and in Germany with Pr Muhlbauer. She combined her work with short travels all around the world for training, congresses and research programs. Her research in anatomy (many flaps discoveries), biochemistry on neurotrophic hormones and in lymphology (anatomy, histology, isotopy, radiology, genetic, biochemistry) were performed from her 2nd year of medicine till now.

Dr. Becker now works in Paris at the American Hospital and the European University Hospital Georges-Pompidou and in the United States at the Westside Regional Medical Center located near Fort Lauderdale, Florida. She is a member of the French Academy of Sur-



gery and an invited professor in New York to develop the lymphedema surgery. Dr Becker participates to various international conferences and operates all around the world. She decided to dedicate her life to patients suffering from lymphedema, a mistreated pathology leading to various complications and destroying the patient quality of life.

Dr Fréderic Bodin is a plastic surgery professor in the

plastic reconstructive and aesthetic unit in Strasbourg. He has a particular interest in breast reconstructive microsugery, and had a research activity in the field of propyhlactic mastectomy.

PHILLIP BLONDEEL **Plastic Surgeon** Gent, Belgium

Phillip Blondeel is an internationally leading expert on

Ghent in 1998.

Professor Blondeel is a fellow of the Collegium Chirurgicum Plasticum (Belgian Boards) and a diplomate of the European Board of Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery. He holds membership in numerous scientific societies, among them the American Society for Reconstructive Microsurgery, the European Association of Plastic Surgeons and the American Society for Plastic Surgery. He is Honorary member of the South-African and Canadian Society of Plastic Surgery.

A world-renowned expert in the field of aesthetic and reconstructive surgery, Professor Blondeel is a much sought after speaker and teacher who has also authored and coauthored numerous books, book chapters, peer-reviewed articles and abstracts. At the end of 2011, Professor Blondeel led the team that performed the first face transplant in Belgium and is the Chair of the Vascularized Composite Tissue Allograft Program at University Hospital Gent.

Giovanni Botti comes from Salò, Lake Garda, Italy and is

the head manager and the main surgeon of Villa Bella Clinic, one of the best equipped and most advanced cosmetic surgery-dedicated clinics in Europe. He has taken part as faculty member in very many aesthetic surgery courses and congresses, organised by both universities and scientific societies in more than 30 different countries.

After studying medicine in Paris,

Dr Fitoussi quickly became internationally known for specialising in all types of surgery of the breast (tumoural, malformative, reconstructive and aesthetic). Dr Fitoussi is general surgeon, considered in oncology, a graduate of microsurgery and plastic, aesthetic and reconstructive surgery.

Having spent ten years at the Hospital of Pitié-Salpêtrière, he integrated the team of the Institute Curie in 1994. He developed the custom-made coverage of breast cancer there, participated in the initiating oncoplasty and in the development of mammary reconstruction by prosthesis followed by musculo-cutaneous scrap. The aesthetic part of breast cancer care, reconstruction and deformities becomes essential and is an integral part of the treatment of these mammary pathologies.

Dr Fitoussi has published several works on surgery of the breast: books of popularisation, books of surgical techniques. He participates in the formation of doctors and surgeons who specialise in surgery of the breast, is responsible for the D.I.U (inter-university diploma) of surgical techniques senologiques, carcinologiques and repair.

A Swiss national of Italian extraction, Rosina is a graduate in business studies. After several years wor-

king in commerce, she decided to retrain in a sector that is very close to her heart, dermopigmentation. Ever since her early childhood she has always showed great enthusiasm for painting and drawing. She has even exhibited her oils on canvas on many occasions. With her sympathetic nature and artistic skills, her chosen profession of dermocosmetics was always a natural progression for Rosina. Over the past 15 years, this peerless artist has established her reputation in the field of corrective and aesthetic dermopigmentation in both Switzerland and abroad. She practices from her surgery in Lausanne and at many hospitals and private surgical clinics. She works closely with various departments at the CHUV teaching hospital in Lausanne and many private doctors, clinics, surgeons, gynaecologists and dermatologists also call on her services. Thanks to her well-established reputation, many patients from abroad also request her services, from France, Germany, Italy and even further afield, such as Singapore...

She is regularly asked to give speeches at medical conferences in Switzerland and abroad, and to produce expert reports in the field of permanent makeup. She has a deep sensibility for corrective dermopigmentation and particularly favours the psychological approach associated with her activities in order to restore a full sense of femininity to women devastated by breast cancer. She masks the vitiligo, skin discolouration and scars. Patients with burns or those suffering from alopecia or a cleft lip also make use of her services. For many years now she has also been working with transgender patients in order to complete gender reassignment surgery with the all-important subtle details. She is able to enhance the femininity or masculinity of the face through aesthetic pigmentation of the eyebrows, eyes or lips, giving the patient renewed confidence and self-assurance. Aesthetic pigmentation, namely permanent makeup, is also part of her day-to-day work for both women and men who wish to enhance their eyebrows, lips or eyes, as well as those who suffer from tremors or poor eyesight, or to athletes and any others for whom the simple act of applying makeup constitutes a complicated task. Over many years now her expertise and experience in corrective and aesthetic dermopigmentation have been acknowledged by hospitals, doctors and patients.

> **GÜNTER GERMANN Plastic Surgeon** Heidelberg, Germany

Dr. Günter Germann was the

President of the internationally renowned and largest German Society of Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgeons. As Head of Department, Professor Dr Germann managed the Berufsgenossenschaftliche Unfallklinik in Ludwigshafen (Ludwigshafen BG Casualty Clinic), Germany, for 18 years, giving it an international reputation. He is considered an excellent microsurgeon within the international arena and has been practising plastic surgery for more than 30 years, with over 25 years of experience in hand surgery. As early as 2001, Professor Germann was awarded the McCormack prize of the University of Rochester (New York) for his scientific work. He is a distinguished member of numerous scientific committees worldwide and has held the Professorship of Plastic Surgery and Hand Surgery at Heidelberg University since 1999. Above and beyond that, Professor German maintains a research laboratory that is primarily dedicated to the development of diagnostic and surgical procedures - also in the area of stem cell research.

> MOUSTAPHA HAMDI Plastic Surgeon Brussels, Belgium

Moustapha Hamdi was born in Syria. He was graduated from

medical school of Damascus University. He did his training in general and plastic surgery in Brussels, Glasgow and Atlanta. He had worked as professor in Gent University for 10 years.

Currently, he is the head of department of plastic and reconstructive surgery in free university of Brussels. He is also a consultant in Edith Cavell Medical Institute.

Pr. Hamdi is an international speaker and organizer of many meetings and courses in breast surgery. His major expertise is breast reconstruction mainly with perforator flaps; however, he has also contributed to many chapters of aesthetic breast surgery.

He is not only chairman of the section of microsurgery within the Royal Belgian Society for Plastic Surgery (RBSPS) and a member of the Belgia Board of Plastic Surgery but he is an expert member of the high council of Ministry of health in Belgium. He is also active within the scientific committee of the European Society of Plastic Surgeons (EURAPS); in addition, he is an honorary member in Australian, Colombian and Syrian societies and a member of the British (BAPS), International (ISAPS), American (ASPS and ASRM) and the World Society of Microsurgery (WSRM) societies.



Dr Per Hedén began his medical training at the Karolinska Institute in Sweden, and entered

plastic surgery training in 1978. He early developed interest in the then emerging field of microsurgery and subsequently became a driving force in establishing microsurgery practice in the region. In 1981 this lead to the first microsurgical operation performed in Stockholm.

In 1982, he was offered a position in Australia. This was followed by plastic surgery research in the U.S. under Professor Elof Eriksson in II-



linois, and at Harvard University in Boston. In 1990 Dr Per Hedén attained associate professorship at Karolinska Institute, and became Head of the microsurgery unit at Sabbatsberg Hospital.

Dr Per Hedén founded Akademikliniken in 1991, which now is one of Europes largest private hospital that specializes in plastic surgery. He has published more than 50 scientific articles, and is a member of many national and international plastic surgical societies.

Professor Hedén has developed several new techniques applying to the use of form stable anatomical breast implants. He has written several textbook chapters on breast augmentation and he has been invited to many countries where he has performed operations to demonstrate his techniques.

Being a very early user of Botulinum toxin and Hyaluronic acid fillers Dr Hedén is also well known for his non-surgical facial rejuvenation techniques and has held numerous international workshops demonstrating his techniques.

Since 2002 Dr Hedén also runs the annual international aesthetic Beauty Through Science meeting inStockholm. This is now northern Europe's largest aesthetic medicine meeting.

Chief of the Plastic Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery Department at Hôpital Européen Georges Pompidou, Dr Laurent Lantieri is sepcialized in Breast reconstruction and microsurgery. He is an innovator, and was the pioneer of breast reconstruction using DIEP flap in France. He also performed the first full-face transplantation.



Patrick Mallucci graduated in

1989 from medical school to embark upon his surgical training. In 1993 he became a fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of England in recognition of this. Having completed his general surgery he undertook his training in Plastic Surgery both in the UK and abroad, London, Oxford, Stoke Mandeville, Australia and Paris. In 1996 he was awarded the higher post graduate degree of Doctorate in Medicine (MD) having spent two years at University College London developing the concept of scarless wound healing. He was awarded the Fellowship of the Royal College of Surgeons in Plastic Surgery, FRCS (Plast.) in 1998. Mr Mallucci is entered into the GMC Specialist Register for Plastic Surgery. He is a full member of the British Association of Plastic Surgeons (BAPS) and the British Association of Aesthetic Plastic Surgeons (BAAPS). He is currently a Consultant Plastic Surgeon at University College London and the Royal Free Hospitals. Mr Mallucci has published comprehensively within the Plastic Surgery Literature throughout his career and presents his work internationally at Plastic Surgery Conferences. In 2012, along with Dr. Liegeois, Jean-Marc Pait created a surgical association within the institute, the "Strasbourg Breast Center", aiming at international development.

Dr Sofia Rivera is an MD, MSc, head of a radiation unit at Gus-

tave Roussy, cancer center, currently finishing her PhD in radiobiology. She is a 39 yearold radiation oncologist working at Gustave Roussy Cancer Center since January 2013.



She has studied medicine and radiation oncology in Paris, Dijon and Madrid (ERASMUS program), with some time spent in Equatorial Guinea (humanitarian mission). She passed the Radiation Oncology Board Certification Exam in 2008 with her medical thesis on the evaluation of quality assurance procedures by dummy run in a phase III trial. During her training, she was charmed by the multidisciplinary nature of radiation oncology and the enormous potential for innovation within this field. In addition to her clinical work, she undertook a Master's degree of Science in Radiobiology and is currently finishing her PhD on a translational radiobiology topic evaluating the combination of a Histone Deacetylase (HDAC) inhibitor and radiation in preclinical in vitro and in vivo Non Small Cell Lung Cancer models at the Gustave Roussy Radiobiology Laboratory (INSERM1030 Unit), running in parallel a phase I trial combining an HDAC inhibitor with palliative irradiation which has just been completed. Following her studies in the Cancer Center of Dijon (France), she also worked as an assistant professor in Radiation Oncology in the university hospital of Saint Louis in Paris while becoming senior radiation oncologist in the same institution. In 2013, she accepted to head Unit A of the radiation oncology department at Gustave Roussy Cancer Center, Paris Cancer Campus, Villejuif (France) leading the breast cancer radiation unit. With eight linear accelerators, and a ninth being installed currently, about 4000 new radiotherapy treatments per year (among which more than a third given to breast cancer patients), she leads a growing multidisciplinary unit at the cutting edge of research and technology in an expanding department in the stimulating environment of a major cancer center. She promotes clinical radiation oncology unit work in close relationship with the INSERM1030 Unit located in nearby preclinical research building, facilitating translational research programs with the integration of research into daily clinical practice.

Mahasti Saghatchian, MSs, is a medical oncologist who joined the staff at the Comprehensive Cancer Centre "Institut Gustave Roussy" (IGR), Villejuif, France, in 2002. She studied Medicine at the University of Paris V before becoming a Board Certified Breast-Oncologist in 1999. She worked as associate Professor in Oncology at Hôpital Européen Georges Pompidou in Paris. After a Masters in Immunology, she followed a Doctoral Research Fellowship at the University of Amsterdam directed by Laura van't Veer on genomic predictors of breast cancer relapse.

Her main interests include breast cancer care and the development of a quality of care programme in European Cancer centres.

She is a member of the Executive Committee of the Transbig Consortium and Mindact Trial, dedicated to translational research in breast cancer.

Her main achievement in the field of European affairs includes chairmanship of the Accreditation-Designation Programme (European programme of assessment of quality of care and designation of comprehensive cancer centres) for the Organisation of European Cancer Institutes (OECI). She has been successfully leading this programme for 13 years, resulting in accreditation and designation of 27 centres in 13 countries. 




